## Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm at Hank Cahill's Dust Bowl  
President's Report and General Business

Hank received a catalog of New Woodturning Books. from Fox Chapel Publishing. A letter from AAW asked members and new turners to renew or join early and receive a \$34 DVD free. Woodworkers Supply requested an address list of members. It was agreed that our membership list should not be made available for mailings.

Hank mentioned that a separate Fuller Craft Museum Exhibit form be included with each piece submitted. Mal had forms available at the meeting and will also have them at Hand's On Saturday, the 10th and at our Christmas Party on the 14th of December. An E-Mail was sent to members with a file of the form for them to print copies.

Mal submitted four months newsletter expenses for \$185.96 to Wally. He also mentioned that MSSW was founded at Hank's Shop November 1996. The idea to form a woodturning group in the area came from a Hank, Wally and few turners that were exhibiting at Marshfield Audubon. The first newsletter was published in May 1997. This is our 104th Newsletter! We currently have 66 members.

Treasurer Wally Kemp reported \$1455 in treasury. He also had 5 gallons of Anchor Seal available for \$11/gal.

Lenny the Librarian is continuing to try to recover overdue videos and books that belong to our library.

Existing officers were elected for 2006 as no volunteers came forward!

Jeff has submitted copies of receipts for equipment purchased to receive our \$500 Grant from AAW to Angelo, who will fax them to AAW. He also gave Liberty Tree documentation he developed to Lenny for distribution to Brockton Officials. Jeff mentioned that our Exhibit at Audubon this year is not as large as previous years and prompted new members to exhibit.

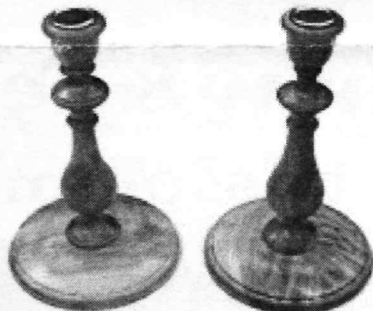

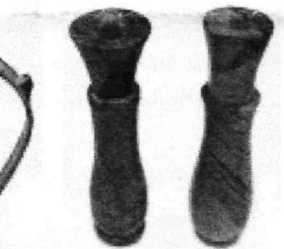

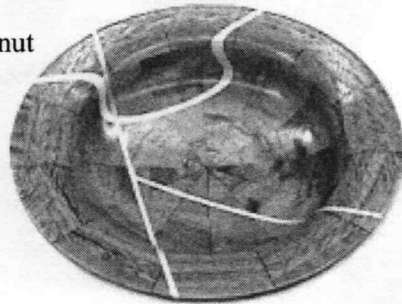
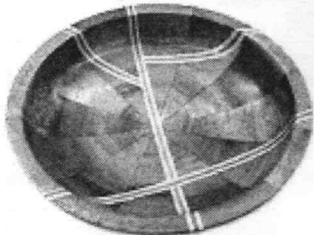

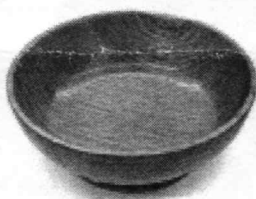
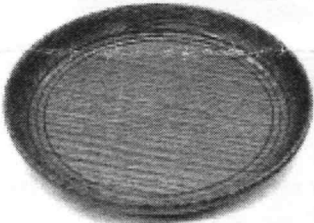

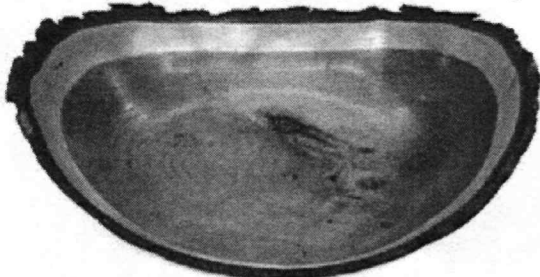

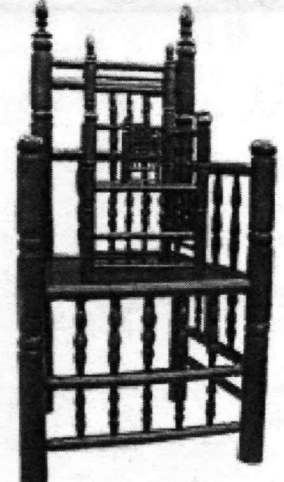
