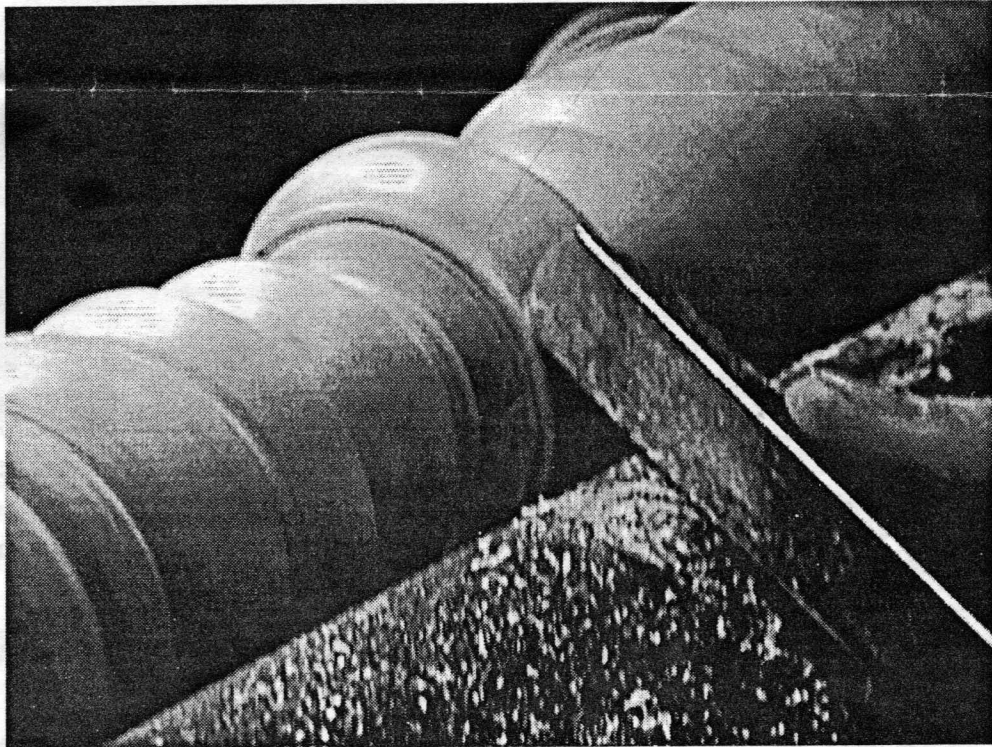

Hank reminded members that the CNEW & WCC Woodturning Symposium is being held Oct. 17th, 1998.

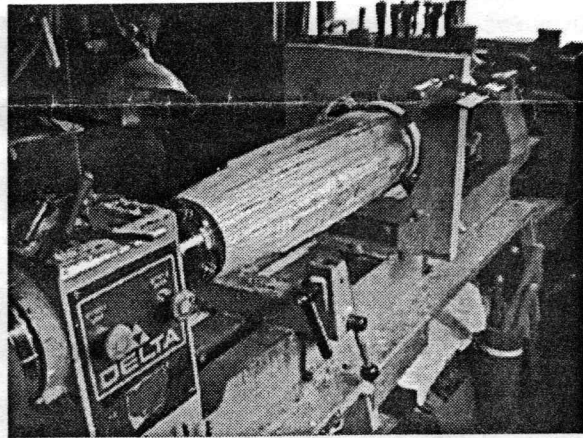
New Business

Show & Tell

Wally Kemp showed a number of turned items using 1 3/4"x 12" spruce Microlam obtained at Cape Cod Lumber. He used West System epoxy for all segmental joints, applying to both sides and filling voids with epoxy and wood dust filler. A large segmented piece was mounted on his lathe ready to be turned to final shape:



Ray Cartier showed a small dish turned from luan decking and a Boce ball from a cedar fence post. Various methods of turning balls were discussed.

Jeff Keller showed a turned bird house. A sewing table purchased at a yard sale with a distorted top was hosed down, flattened and refinished.

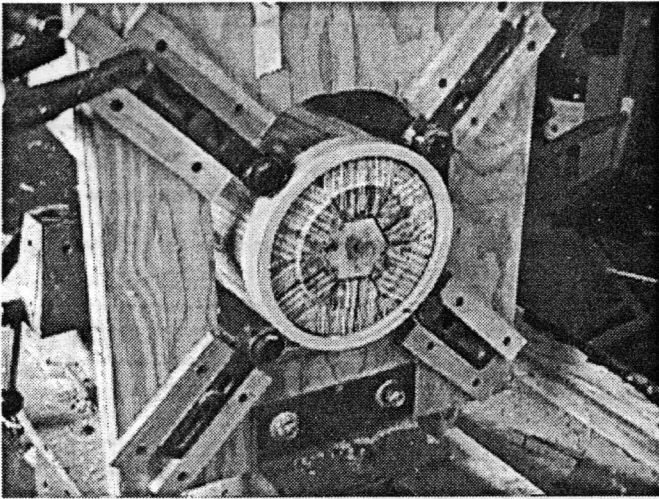
Hank Cahill showed curly maple bowls turned from 1992 stock stored in bags of chips. Also boxes turned from Microlam and a small plate and dish turned from laminated oak used for **USS Constitution** repair. Walnut was combined with this material to create a nice box.

Demonstration

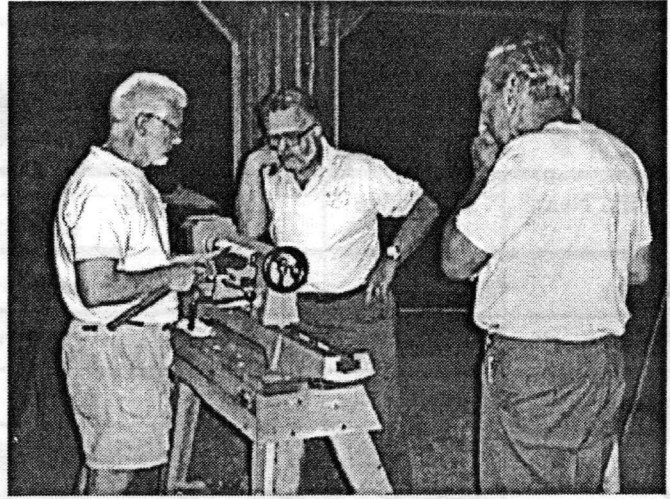

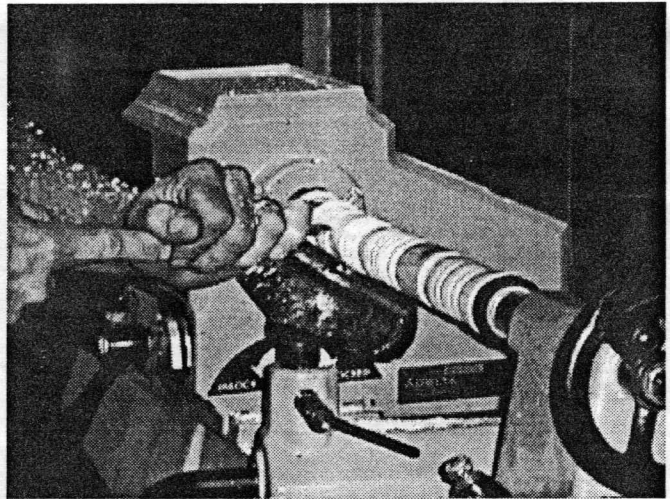
Wally's steady rest. Ball bearings run against ring cut from PVC pipe to reduce noise. Note Microlam segments.



Ray Cartier explains correct technique while Emilio thinks about it.

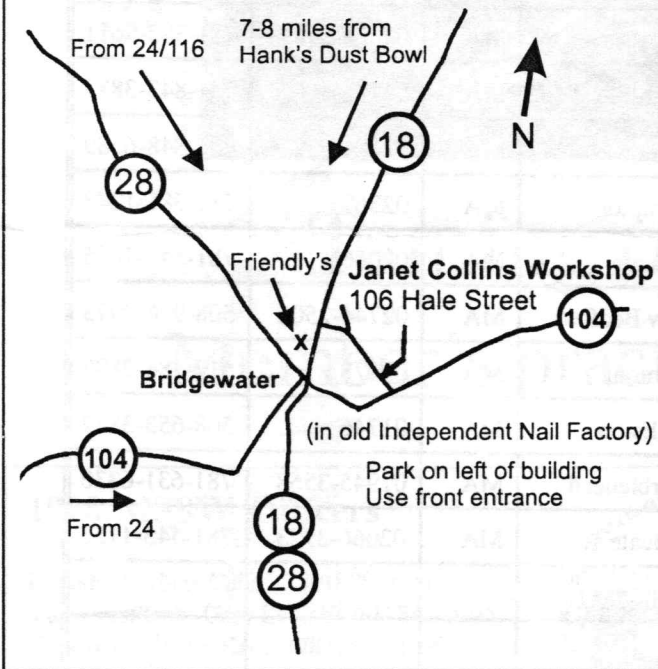
Welcome New Member Jeffrey Keller

He has a ShopSmith Lathe, '53 vintage, and is interested in antique cars and furniture.



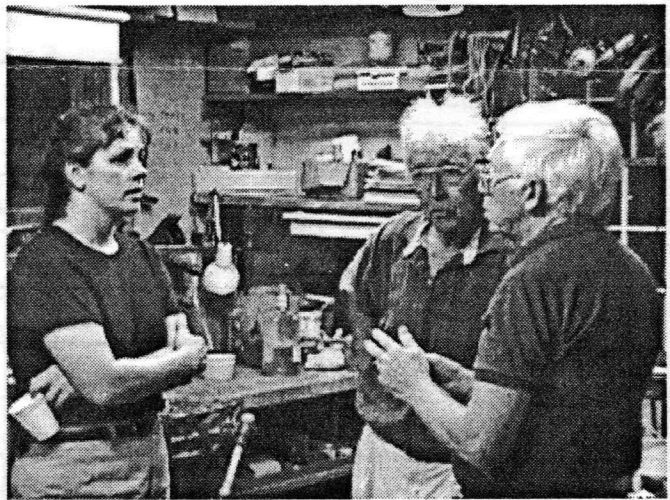
