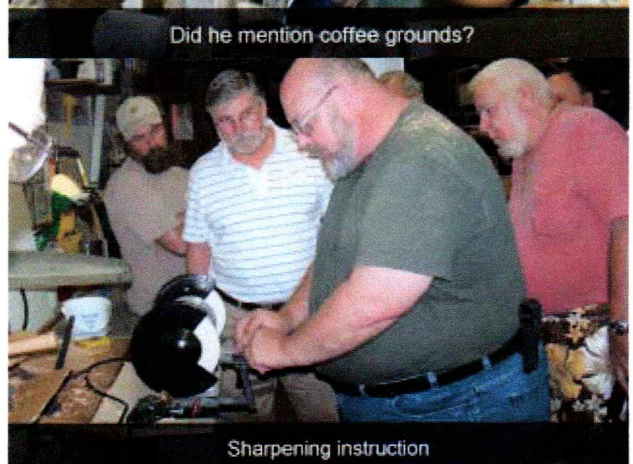
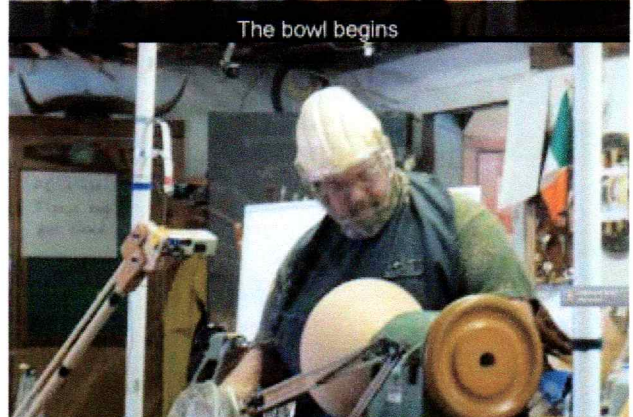
Don Diedrich made a presentation on recording demonstrations for our library. What equipment is needed was reviewed. He also described a light source to be built.

Hand's On at Hank's shop to be held Saturday, August 22nd. at 10am.

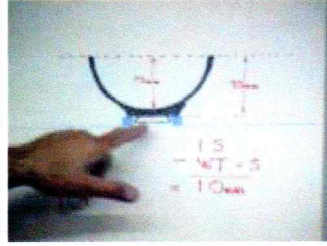

Preparing chuck for bowl and pressing bowl in place

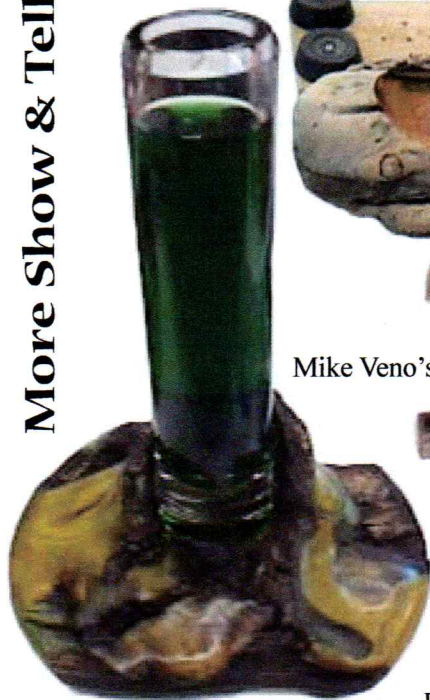


Cotton cloth between bowl and chuck for snug fit and turning bowl bottom. Nigel reviews procedure and results.

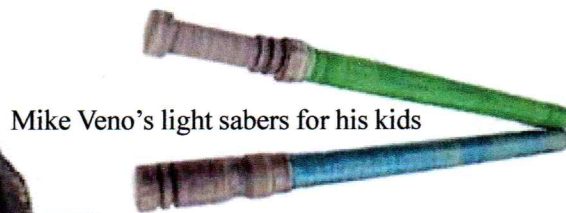
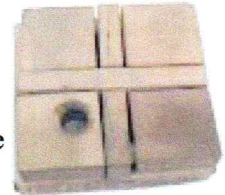

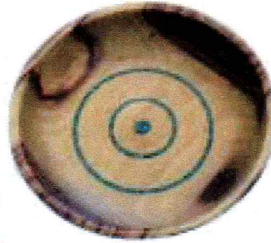
