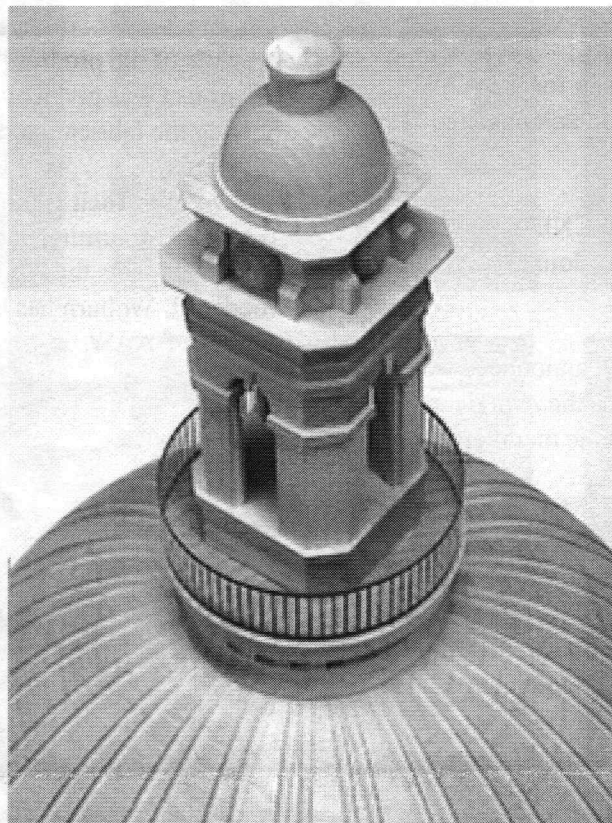

distributed among members. Registered turners are allowed 3 pieces for display. The gallery and trade show is open to the public.

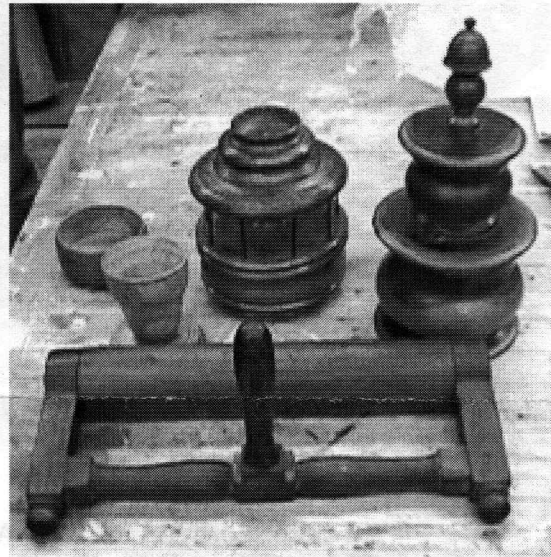

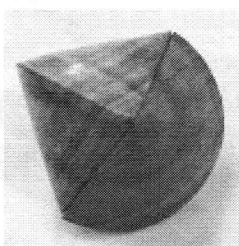


# Emilio demonstrated turning a Wibble Wobble

No captions - you had to be there as Emilio Wibbled and Wobbled through the demonstration!



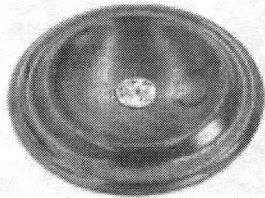

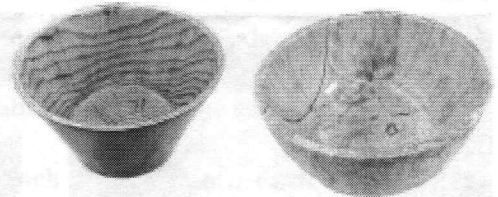

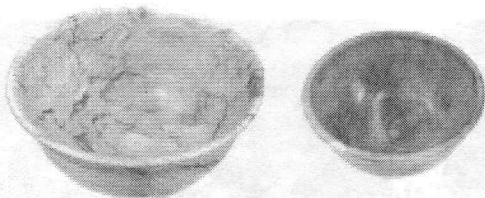

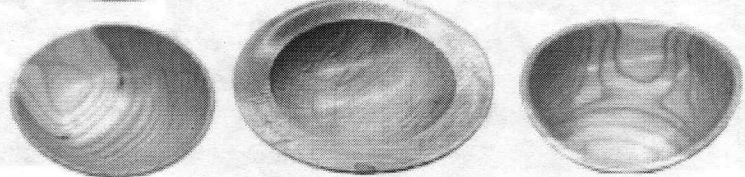
