(And there may be more in this newsletter!)

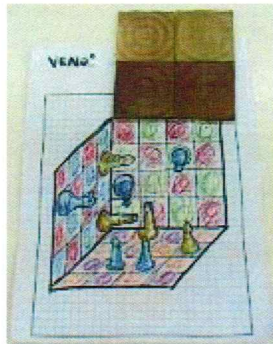

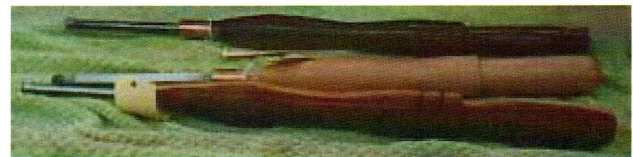

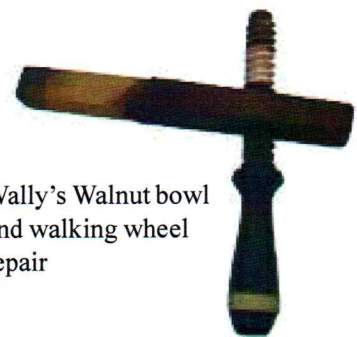

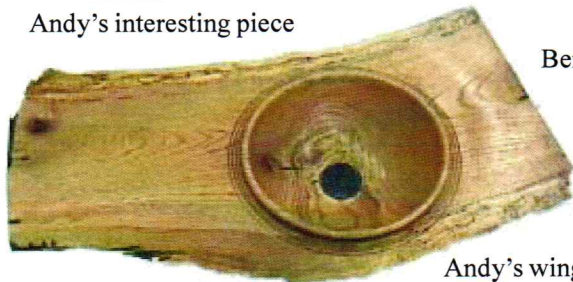
