## Show & Tell



Billy holds a lighthouse, one of four he turned and brought along to show us. This one is spalted maple. Billy said he covered the whole piece in CA glue when turning it. It features a suncatcher crystal.

Charlie is holding one of two lidded vases he turned. This one is birch with a threaded lid. Charlie mentioned that he bought two furniture pulls at Hobby Lobby to use as lids. Charlie told us he used Danish Oil and the Wipe On Poly for the finish.



Tim is holding a mallet he turned from white oak. He designed the handle to fit in his hand. He says it will stand up on either end



Andy showed us this spindle turned piece from padauk. It started as a maple branch, then he cut it, drilled it and turned it until it had a nice easy fit into the bottom part. He then dyed and applied some paint.

Vince brought along this cherry cane he turned. It unscrews in the middle and comes with the knob shown here courtesy of a kit he purchased from Woodcraft. He says Rockler has a kit also.



Horace is holding a platter turned from maple which measures 11 1/2" in diameter. Nice piece.



Horace showed us an oak footed maple vase with a walnut finial on the lid. The vase checked in the turning process so Horace filled it epoxy. It stands 15 1/2" high.



Ken has an elaborate stand with two bowls. He found a walnut base at the town dump, brought it home and burned and pierced it. He then added the two bowls then pierced the surface of each. He turned a friction fit base for the bowls to fit into the base, and used green dye on the bowl pictured at the left.



Molly is holding a bottle stopper with a finial. She told us she added the beads and coves to help her warm up. Interesting design.





Wayne holds an ice cream scoop, one of the three that he turned.



Peter Soltz shows a platter turned from poplar with Walnut strips forming the cross pattern. He finished it with linseed oil and wax.



Peter Shows off a small Oak Footed bowl.



Joe is holding a Pendis Sphere. He used hot glue to hold two pieces together while he turned them then he broke them apart and rotated and reglued the two pieces for a final turning for the piece shown here. Interesting piece.
